Consultation on Proposed Changes to School Admissions Criteria and Planned Admissions Number – September 2020

All Saints Catholic High School are consulting with interested parties with regards to changes in its Admission Policy.

The first change is in connection with Looked After Children and previously Looked After Children.

The current policy states:-

1. Looked After Children and previously Looked After Children.

The proposed revision would state:-

1. Looked After Children and Previously Looked After Children. This includes children who appear to have been in state care outside of England and cease to be in state care as a result of being adopted.

The second change proposed is in connection with the Planned Admission Number (PAN) for the school. All Saints currently has a PAN of 210 pupils. The proposal is to reduce this down to 200, to ensure overall capacity in the school can be managed.
