Year 7 Catch-up Premium Budget 2016/17

The allocation for the 2016/7 is £17,500. This funding has been allocated to fund additional literacy lessons for Year 7 students in English.

Year 7 Catch-up Premium Budget 2015/16

The allocation for the 2015/6 was £17,500. This allocation was spent on one to one tuition for Year 7 students in English and Maths.

English

- 18 students in term 1 - 11/18 made progress, 7 by 1 sub level, 3 by 2 sublevels and 1 by 3 sublevels
- 9 students in term 2 - 7/9 made progress, 3 by 1 by 1 sub level, 2 by 2 sublevels and 4 by 3 sublevels

Mathematics

- 9 students in term 1 - 4/9 achieved level 5+, 5/9 achieved level 4+
- 6 students in term 2 - 2/6 achieved level 5+, 6/6 achieved level 4+

Year 7 Catch-up Premium Expenditure 2014/15

The allocation for the academic year 2014 -15 was £17,500. The allocation was spent on the Year 7 Catch-up Intervention.

English

- 60 pupils on Levels 4c – 3b
- 4 classes, received an additional 2 hours per week until Christmas to secure Level 4.

Mathematics

- 39 pupils on Levels 4c – 3b
- 3 classes received an additional 2 hours per week until Christmas to secure Level 4

By the end of the Year 7:

- 38 pupils in English had secured level 4b or above
- 26 pupil in Mathematics had secured level 4b or above
